COVID - 19

In order to prevent the spread of COVID-19 it is important to know and recognise the symptoms of coronavirus (which includes the DELTA variant).

Common symptoms of coronavirus include:

- a fever (high temperature - 38 degrees Celsius or above).
- a new cough - this can be any kind of cough, not just dry.
- shortness of breath or breathing difficulties.
- loss or change in your sense of smell or taste - this means you've noticed you cannot smell or taste anything, or things smell or taste different to normal
- Fatigue
- Aches and Pains

Other uncommon symptoms of coronavirus include:


- sore throat
- headaches
- runny or stuffy noses
- feeling sick or vomiting
- diarrhoea

Do not send your child to school if they have ANY Covid 19 symptoms.

Do not send your child to school if your child been in close contact with someone who has tested positive for coronavirus or has been living with someone who is unwell and may have coronavirus




